### Flag Rules for use on CPS boats

Notes: If more than one flag or pennant is designated for one position, the preferred order of precedence is given in the left-hand column, beginning with the Canadian flag.

\* The Squadron Pennant may be flown only when the CPS flag is flown. Hoist of the pennant not to be greater than the CPS flag flying at the same time.

\*\* Yacht Club Burgee has the same precedence as the CPS flag. A few clubs fly their burgee from the masthead.

\*\*\* Preferred practice, but may be flown day and night while vessel is in commission.

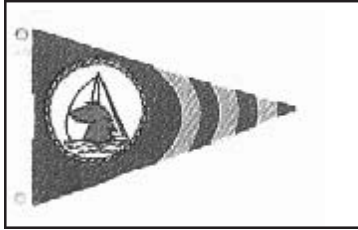




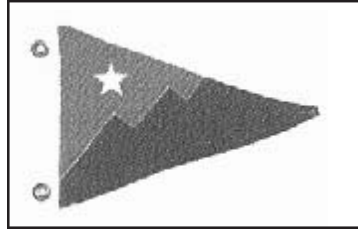

### Squadron and District Pennants:

#### Shapes:

A Squadron/District Pennant is a flag with a hoist measuring two-thirds its fly: (a) Commonly pointed, triangular, (b) often truncated, (c) sometimes swallow-tailed, and, (d) occasionally, a long thin streamer.

To be compatible with CPS Flags, Squadron/District pennants should measure: (a) 8" x 12", or (b) 12" x 18".

#### Size and use of flags:

- (a) Canadian flag: 1 inch fly to 1 foot of length of the vessel.
- (b) CPS Flag: (i) Power: 5/8" fly to 1 foot of length of the vessel.  
(ii) Sail: 1/2" fly for each foot of the highest masthead above the water.
- (c) Squadron/District Pennants. A Squadron or District pennant may not be displayed in the absence of or in lieu of the CPS Flag, and its hoist must not be greater than the hoist of the CPS flag flying at the same time.
